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THE CONTEST:

Phoenixville Area Community Services (“PACS”) will be hosting their 13th Annual Empty Bowls Event on November 1, 2019 at the Technical College High School – Pickering Campus. In connection with that event, PACS is holding a t-shirt design contest (this “Contest”)! Submit your original design and it may be selected to appear on PACS’ Official T-shirt, in PACS’ event and general marketing materials, and on PACS’ website and social media accounts! **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE DOES NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.**

SPONSOR:

PACS is the sponsor and administrator of the Contest and is responsible for the fulfillment of the prize. Entrants should look solely to PACS for any questions, comments, or problems related to the Contest and agree that PACS has the sole right to decide all matters and disputes arising from the Contest and that its decisions are final and binding.

ELIGIBILITY:

This Contest is open only to legal residents of Pennsylvania who are students in grades 9 through 12 and who live, or attend high school, in PACS’ service area, which consists of the areas in the following zip codes: 19460, 19481, 19482, 19496, 19442, 19425, 19453, and 19456 (each, an “Entrant” and collectively, “Entrants”). This Contest is void in all other areas and where prohibited by law. Employees, volunteers, and board members of PACS and their relatives are not eligible to participate. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply.

THE PRIZE:

The Winner (as defined below) will receive One Hundred Dollars (\$100), plus two Official PACS t-shirts featuring his/her design and four tickets to the 2019 PACS 12th Annual Empty Bowls Event (collectively, the “Prize”)! No prize substitution is permitted. The Prize is non-transferrable and any taxes on the Prize are the Winner’s responsibility.

CONTEST DATES:

This Contest runs from 8:00 am EST on Tuesday, September 3, 2019 and ends at 4:00 pm EST on Friday, October 4, 2019 (the “Contest Period”). The winner will be notified and publicly announced on or around Tuesday, October 8, 2019.

DESIGN GUIDELINES:

Designs will appear on the front of the t-shirt only and must be easy to reproduce. All designs must include PACS logo, be relevant and appropriate to PACS’ mission, and be original works created solely by the student submitting it. Designs must be submitted as vector PDF, Photoshop psd, or high-resolution scan formats. Any other file format will not be accepted or considered. Use of the PACS logo is permitted solely for the purposes of this Contest and limited to the terms outlined herein; use of any other artwork/logos or other trademarked content not provided is prohibited. With the sole exception of the PACS provided and designated logos and slogans, any use of any photo, drawing, images, elements, or text created by another person, is strictly prohibited and will result in disqualification. The right to use PACS designated logos, slogans, or trademarks is limited to this Contest and such logos, slogans, and trademarks may not be used for any other purpose. Entries that may be considered inappropriate, offensive, defamatory or objectionable, in PACS’ sole opinion and discretion, or which are in violation of any person’s right to privacy, intellectual property, or other rights are not welcome, and any received will be disqualified. Entrants may not modify their design once submitted

HOW TO ENTER:

During the Contest Period, Entrants may submit one entry and one design using the following email address: Development@pacspbx.org. If an Entrant submits more than one entry and/or design, only the first entry and design received will be considered and all additional entries and designs will not be accepted or considered. Please include “T-Shirt Design Contest” in the subject line of your entry submission email. Be sure to include a completed Entry Form, with your parent’s

signature as well if you are under 18. Entries which do not include a fully completed Entry Form and/or which are submitted by mail, hand delivery, or via any other means will not be accepted or considered. No entries or designs will be returned or acknowledged except as expressly provided herein.

OWNERSHIP OF WINNING ENTRY:

PACS will have the sole and exclusive right to own, publish, reproduce, use, edit, adapt, modify, and/or publicly perform the winning design in any and all media worldwide, now known or hereafter developed, without limitation and without notice or additional consideration to the Winner. PACS will have the right to receive all proceeds from the sale or use of any merchandise or other materials using the winning entry, without any fee or royalty to the Winner, other than the Prize described herein, which the Winner agrees is adequate and sufficient. The winning design will be credited to the Winner in all promotions relevant to the PACS T-shirt Design Contest, and in PACS' general marketing and advertising materials. PACS may disqualify the entry and/or discontinue use of the submitted design if ownership is challenged in any manner, by any person.

WINNER SELECTION:

Valid entries will be judged by PACS representatives. Designs will be judged on artistic elements including, without limitation: (i) the design's relevance to the Empty Bowls event; (ii) creativity; (iii) originality; (iv) visual presentation; and (v) color selection. PACS reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to select the winning design or to not select a winning design should none of the designs submitted meet the design guidelines and/or be appropriate for PACS and/or the PACS' Empty Bowls event.

WINNER VALIDATION & CERTIFICATION:

The Entrant who submitted the winning design will be notified via email and will be required to sign and return legal documents conveying ownership of their entry to PACS and consenting to the use of his/her name and likeness in connection with the event and PACS' use of the Entrant's design as provided herein. All such legal documents must be returned to PACS via email, fax, or mail within two (2) days from the date and time of notification or that Entrant will be disqualified, the Prize will be forfeited, and a new winning design will be selected. No Entrant will be certified the winner (the "Winner") until his/her eligibility is verified, he/she receives notification from PACS of his/her selection as the winner, and PACS timely receives all required legal documents fully signed and executed by the Entrant and if Entrant is under 18 years old, by Entrant's parent/guardian as well. **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS; LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:**
